Eddy Isaacs, Ph.D.

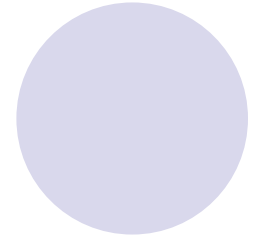
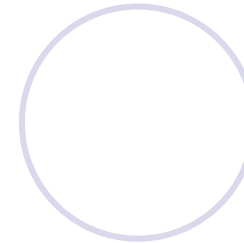
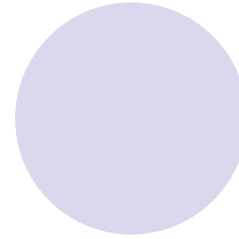
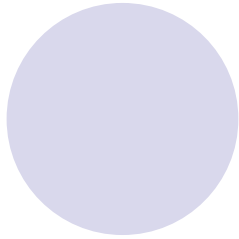
Eddy Isaacs will be giving a first hand account of the transition from the Alberta Energy Research Institute into Alberta Innovates Energy and Environment Solutions (EES). He will share some insights into how this new entity is positioning Alberta as a leader in the low carbon energy economy.

Eddy is the CEO of EES with responsibility for Alberta’s strategic directions and investments in energy technologies, environmental technologies and renewable and emerging resources.

He has been instrumental in promoting innovation in energy and environment across Canada and has served as co-Chair of the Energy Technology Working Group of the Canadian Council of Energy Ministers.

Eddy holds a Ph.D. from the University of Alberta and a B.Sc. from McGill University. He has over 70 publications and 6 patents in the energy field.

Eddy is a Fellow of the Canadian Academy of Engineering and currently serves on the Boards of the Petroleum Technology Alliance of Canada (PTAC), NRC Institute for Fuel Cells Innovation (NRC IFCI) and NRC Institute for Chemical Process and Environmental Technology (NRC ICPET).
